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College Profile

Established in June 2015, the journey of G.C, Kheri Gujran has been an eventful one. The college shifted to its newly constructed building in January 2017. Since then the growth and achievements of this college have been exponential. The college is spread over a sprawling campus of 19 acres. With dedicated efforts of college leadership, the college has recently been granted a sanction of Rupees 6.5 Crore for a new Auditorium of 500 seating capacity. The college campus has well developed lawns providing a nice ambience of greenery. The college aims to create an environment for imparting holistic education and to inculcate a sense of discipline and values amongst students. The college has well-maintained indoor and outdoor sports facilities. The college has earned a good image in its region and attracts enormous interest from students for admission. At present the college has 776 students (boys 551 and girls 225) on its rolls in two courses B.A. and B. Com being run in the college.

College Staff

The college has the most supportive group of entire staff and ably guided in its mission to provide quality education to every student by its dynamic Principal Mrs. Krishna Sheoran. The efforts of the Principal Mrs. Krishna Sheoran in this regard are laudable, who like a true visionary steered the whole team to success for a better tomorrow. The efforts are amplified by the proactive approach of our new leader Dr. Sunil Sharma who is a truly a bringing changes on ground level for student welfare. The college now has 21 sanctioned teaching posts out of which 7 regular, 2 on deputation and 8 extension lecturers are working at present. The non-teaching staff has 9 members which comprises of two clerks, one restorer, and six class IV employees.

College Bursar

Sh. Jai Parkash from Department of Commerce is the true custodian of intuitional funds. He manages the financial matters with strong sense of commitment and his financial acumen.

College Achievements

1. In September 2021, College earned the distinction of getting its AAA (Academic and Administrative Audit) conducted by an external Committee led by experts under the UGC-PARAMARSH scheme. The audit committee was satisfied with the working of the college and accorded suitable grade. This will be beneficial for college's NAAC accreditation which the college is gearing up for in full flow.
2. Owing to popular student demand, the college has been granted 1 unit of P.G. course - M.A. Psychology in the current academic session 2021-22.
3. 20 students of the college will participate in cultural programme of "Khelo India Youth Games 2022" where Honorable Prime Minister Narendra Nodi will grace the occasion as Chief Guest.

College Library

Reading adds newer dimensions to the body of knowledge. GC Kheri Gujran believes in inculcating a reading culture that enhances and compliments the education system. The library has been constantly upgraded to provide access to best resources for students and staff. Now, it has 2445 books and subscribes 5 newspapers in English and Hindi. To boost its e-resources, the college has subscribed to N-list, British Council Library and two new Journals. Also, SOUL software has been installed for maintaining library books database, budgeting and overall Library Management.

College Website

The college now has its own website with registered domain name. With the new look, it is updated regularly and provides ready information about the college, courses, lesson plans, admission, latest news and events and daily activities. The website can now be accessed at www.gckherigujran.ac.in

College Infrastructure

College has adequate infrastructure to support its operations. There are 14 classrooms, 6 smart rooms, 1 Multipurpose Hall, 1 Library, 1 sports ground, 1 Common room, subject labs, Indoor sports rooms, Language lab, office rooms, parking area and lush lawns. To sustain future expansion plans, college infrastructure will be boosted by addition of a new academic building block and 1 auditorium. With dedicated efforts of college leadership in this direction, the college has recently been granted a sanction of Rupees 6.5 Crore for a new Auditorium of 500 seating capacity.

Academic Achievements of Faculty Members

3. Dr. Tanushree Dahiya completed two-week online refresher course in Psychology organized by TLC Ramanujan College in association with The center for Psycho-social Resource Development and Training (CPRDT) Ramanujan College from 12th April to 26th April 2021.
4. Ms. Neeti Panwar, Assistant Professor, Commerce completed one-month Faculty Induction Programme from Aligarh Muslim University from 7th September to 12th October 2021. She also published 5th edition of her textbook "Investing in Stock Markets" from Taxmanns' Publication.
5. Dr. Ritesh Kalra published 1 paper titled "Trends in Consumer forums: A comparative study of Karnal and Kurukshetra District Consumer Forums of Haryana" in proceedings of International conference "Marketing of Information Products & Services " held at Aggarwal College, Ballabgarh. He also completed his refresher course from Jamia Milia Islamia University, Delhi.

6. Dr. Rajesh Kumar, Extension Lecturer, English published 4 research papers in International Journals of repute.

Scholarship Committee

Many types of scholarship are granted to the students of the college with the help of DHE. Various types of scholarship are available for students, viz.,

1. Consolidated Stipend Scheme for S.C. Students
2. Post Matric Scholarship Scheme for B.C. Students
3. Girls Merit Scholarship Scheme
4. Haryana State Merit Scholarship
5. Meritorious Incentive Scholarship Scheme

As most recent data available for the year 2021-22, 355 applications have been approved so far and scholarship money has been disbursed for 248 applications.

Cultural Activities

The college aims at the holistic development of the students, be it in academics or cultural activities. College maintains a culture where the students are allowed to explore their potential by showcasing their talents. The cultural activities committee is ably headed by Dr Sunil Sharma. Summary of events and achievements is as follows:

1. A 'Talent search Competition' was organized in college Auditorium in which college students were given an opportunity to show their talents in the fields of Dance, Music, Theatre, Literary and Fine Arts.
2. Our students participated in many fine arts, literary and theatre events in Zonal Youth Festival held at Pt. JLN Govt. College, Faridabad in December 2021. The college won Second prize in Mime event and Poonam of B.Com I won Third prize in Rangoli for the college.
3. Abovementioned winners of Zonal Youth Festival represented Faridabad Zone in University Youth Festival held at M.D.U. Rohtak in March 2022. Both the teams brought laurels to college by winning First Position in Mime and Third Position in Rangoli competition.
4. Our students won First prize in Mime event in Inter-college Competition held at Amity University, Noida on 12th April 2022.

Sports Activities & Achievements

The college believes in motivating students on how sports and academics go hand in hand for the all round development of an individual. In 2021-22 indoor games facility has been boosted by adding table tennis, chess, carom, etc and creation of a separate indoor sports Room. Capitalizing on the infrastructure provided, the Students of the college have been consistently performing well in different events like- Athletics, Taekwondo, Kick Boxing, Shot-put, etc. and play the games in the true spirit of sportsmanship. The current achievements in sports area are as follows:

1. Tulsi of B.A. 1st Year won 3rd position in 20 Km Women Race in University Games held MD University in her debut race itself.
2. Sagar of B.A. 3rd Year won 3rd position in Shotput throw in the M.D University Games.

Placement Cell

Placement cell of the college operates with the objective of to guide and prepare the students for career opportunities and also to develop their personalities. Under placement cell latest books were bought to help the students on many topics (like skill development, competition, reasoning, quantitative and language). Regular extension

lectures were arranged from time to time for students by inviting eminent resource persons on different subjects like Interview Skills, Resume Writing, Freelancing by commerce students, career opportunities and certification courses in IT, career in geography, Company Secretary course, POSH Trainer, etc. An orientation session with SACC centre of Faridabad was organized in which students were acquainted with the entrepreneurship support schemes of Govt. of Haryana and also the mentorship programmes held by SACC on regular basis. Students participated in large numbers.

National Service Scheme (NSS)

1. On 08th April 2021, the college has been declared as Tobacco Free Education Institution.
2. A one-day NSS Camp was held on 08-04-2022 where students did Shramdaan for cleaning of college gardens and lawns.
3. NSS unit of the college observed Earth Day on 22th April 2022 wherein a lecture was organized to spread awareness about environmental issues like pollution, menace of polythene, misuse of electricity, etc. A rally procession was done by students to emphasize the aforementioned issues among public. The camp concluded with a tree plantation drive.
4. A one-week NSS Camp was organized from 28th April-4th May 2022 in which following activities were conducted:
 - a. Lectures by prominent experts with touch points on important social ideas like Beti Bachao, Beti Pado, Ideologies of Mahatma Gandhi , Crimes against women, etc
 - b. First –aid training was given to Camp participants.
 - c. Various competitions like poster making, badge making, debate, speech, rangoli, sports, etc were held to promote the spirit of excellence among students.
 - d. The Camp concluded with a Blood Donation Camp held on last day in which 29 units of blood were collected.

Youth Red Cross

A General Health Check-up Camp and Consultancy session was organized by the Youth Red Cross Unit of the College in association with NIMA (National Integrated Medical Association) and Women Cell of the college. More than 200 students participated in the camp and free medicines were distributed to them.

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Women Cell

The women cell organized a spree of planned activities for girl students and staff members. A continuing Self-defence training Workshop was held on weekly basis during November 2021-January 2022 in association with Sterling Taekwondo Association Delhi. A Sanitary Napkin Vending Machine has been installed under the instructions of DHE, Panchkula to provide sanitary pads for girl students. A Thalassemia awareness seminar was organized on 01 December 2021 in collaboration with GIFT (Globally Integrated Foundation for Thalassemia).

Other Activities of the College

1. Independence Day Celebration: A Flag Hoisting Ceremony was organized in college campus on 15th August 2021 followed by National Anthem. Sweets were also distributed to the staff and students.
2. National Library Day was observed on 12th August 2021 by conducting a Tree Plantation Drive where students planted sapling in college campus and Principal Mrs. Krishna Sheoran threw light on importance of trees for our environment and future.
3. 400th Birth Anniversary of Shri Guru Teg Bahadur was celebrated by conducting essay competition, lectures and student-faculty discourses on his exemplary life, valor and sacrifice during 1-7th April 2022.
4. In buildup to the International Day of Yoga 2022, amongst various other activities like Pledge, Poster making, Quiz, etc; a 6-days Yoga Training Workshop was organized for students and staff members by a professionally trained Yoga Teacher from 09th-14th May 2022.

Department of Geography

Department of Geography participated in Science Exhibition organized by Govt. Palwal and won 2nd Prize at District Level. The department regularly organizes activities like poster making competition, extension lectures, debates for student welfare and also create awareness among stakeholders about relevant topics like environment issues, No Tobacco campaign, tree plantation, and traffic rules. Furthermore, to provide platform to students' voice, Department conducted an intra-college Debate Competition on the topic "Hindrances and issues caused by Modern lifestyle in conservation of natural resources".

Department of Psychology

A Series of Group discussion was organised on "Why I select or opt or choose psychology as a subject", "The Role of sport psychology in women's life" and "Importance of Developmental psychology in human life" during April-May 2022. Also, student presentations were held on "Importance of Applied psychology in modern scenario". Students actively participated and presented their ideas and views with great enthusiasm.

Department of Commerce

Department of Commerce organized an intra department Computer Quiz on 08-04-2022 for first year students to spread IT awareness among the students.
